



## 9 - 12 VI 2011 HH TULKU URGYEN CHEMCHOG Rinpoche in Szczecin, Poland



*„His Holiness TULKU URGYEN CHEMCHOG Rinpoche was born on August 15th 1956 in Kalimpong as the third child of Venerable Tertön Chimed Rigzin Rinpoche and his wife, Sangye Dolma. When he was a small boy he was recognized by the late incarnations of His Holiness Dudjom Rinpoche and His Holiness Gyalwa Karmapa as the highest Tulku of Suckchung Monastery, which was kept secret until 1985 when during his first visit in Tibet in Khordong Monastery He was offered a carpet of the highest throne of the Suckchung Monastery as a sign of Rinpoche's return to the monastery. In 1990 during His second trip to Tibet, on the 10th day of fourth month He was enthroned. On the first day of new Tibetan year in 2002 His Holiness Chimed Rigzin Rinpoche announced Tulku the head of Gumpa and His main Regent bound to continue His work in The East and West.*

*Tulku Urgyen Chemchog is the son of body, speech and mind of The Most Honorable Tulku Khordong Terchen Chimed Rigzin Rinpoche. His father fed him with great concern, physically, psychically and spiritually since the early childhood. Recognizing Tulku Urgyen as an important reincarnation and making him a Chief Regent (tib. rGyal tshabs), Rinpoche entrusted Tulku Urgyen with holy traditions of Khordong Lineage and many beneficial Dharma projects, which were personally tended and promoted by Rinpoche and which were propagated by masters of Khordong Lineage before him, for the benefit of their students and future generations. Since the departure of Tertul Rinpoche (Chimed Rigzin Rinpoche), Tulku Urgyen dedicated every conscious moment of His life with selflessness in charge of Rinpoches projects, Khordong Gumpa in India and communities in The West. I'm very happy that all the students of Rinpoche help Tulku Urgyen like one body in fulfilling the enlightened wishes of Rinpoche and Tulku Ugyen...". -Tulku Thondup*
